The next step is to fill your raised bed Purchase or prepare a soil mix with high organic matter When using a soil mix, good landscaping companies offer separate mixes for different uses For example, one with coarser soil may work well for a lawn but not for a raised vegetable bed Choose a mix that has good nutrient and water-holding capacity
